DECEMBER SESSION HIGHLIGHTS

A stated meeting was held on Wednesday, December 11 at 6:30 pm in the Community Room.

Financial Report: We have borrowed \$5500 from other accounts in 2019. Expenses have been kept down. We anticipate a deficit of around \$10,000. A preliminary budget for 2020 was approved.

2020 Pledges: We have received 45 pledges totaling \$108,376. (In 2019, we had 37 pledges totaling \$96,650.

General Mission Giving (to Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly): the Session decided to not pay this for 2019 and to reconsider what to do for 2020 in six months.

Children's Ministry: Starting in January, we will offer Sunday School for PreK through Grade 6 on the third and fourth Sundays, during worship. Children and teachers will leave after the anthem and/or Discovery Time. We will be using a PC(USA) curriculum, Awesome Adventures. Wednesday Early Outs (WEO) will continue once per month.

Epiphany Celebration on Sunday, January 5, during and after worship. Congregation is invited to bring gifts as the Magi did, but for Southeast Linn Community Center (Toilet Paper, facial tissues, lotion, lip balm) and Washington Elementary School (Girls underwear sizes 6-6X and black sweatpants sizes 4T through 14/16).
