

Forgive us, Holy God, when our praise is manipulative rather than unfettered.

Forgive us, Powerful God, when we think you need us to save you rather than the other way round.

Forgive us, God, for treating you like an object in our possession,

to be shown off or played with or left to gather dust until we want something.

Make our praise wholehearted and genuine,

our commitment to your way rather than our own,

and our joy fulfilled.

We ask in the name of the One who embodies your presence among us, Jesus the Christ. Amen.

SCRIPTURE

Leader: In the beginning was the Word.

All: And the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Leader: And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us.

2 Samuel 5:1-5 (NRSV) - David Anointed King

Reader 1: Then all the tribes of Israel came to David at Hebron and said, "Look, we are your bone and flesh. For some time, while Saul was king over us, it was you who led out Israel and brought it in. The Lord said to you, 'It is you who shall be shepherd of my people Israel, you who shall be ruler over Israel.' "So all the elders of Israel came to the king at Hebron, and King David made a covenant with them at Hebron before the Lord, and they anointed David king over Israel. David was thirty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned forty years. At Hebron he reigned over Judah seven years and six months, and at Jerusalem he reigned over all Israel and Judah thirty-three years.

2 Samuel 6:1-5 (NRSV) - The Ark of the Lord is Brought to Jerusalem

Reader 2: David again gathered all the chosen men of Israel, thirty thousand. David and all the people with him set out and went from Baale-judah to bring up from there the ark of God, which is called by the name of the Lord of hosts who is enthroned on the cherubim. They carried the ark of God on a new cart and brought it out of the house of Abinadab, which was on the hill. Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab, were driving the new cart with the ark of God, and Ahio went in front of the ark. David and all the house of Israel were dancing before the Lord with all their might, with songs and lyres and harps and tambourines and castanets and cymbals.
